

## N.E.W.Ts Nastily Exhausting Wizarding Tests

Each subject has 3 pass grades. A for Acceptable, E for Exceeded Expectation & O for Outstanding (the highest grade level). Each grade requires a book fulfilling the prompt assigned to it. Each A unlocks the possibility to gain an E, thus, in order to achieve an Outstanding you first must earn an A and an E, in that particular order (A-E-O). There is no cross-over or doubling up on books allowed.

Ancient Runes	A: Ehwaz (partnership)-a book recommended by a friend
	E: a historical fiction book
	O: a book that has been on your TBR for ages
Arithmancy	A: a book that ends on an even page number
	E: a stand-alone book
	O: a book that's longer than 350 pages
Astronomy	A: a book with a moon on the cover or in the title
	E: the word "night" in the book title or series name
	O: a sci-fi book
Care of Magical Creatures	A: a book that starts with "A" for Aragog
	E: a book under 300 pages
	O: Grab onto Fawke's tail! Read a book with a bird on the cover
Charms	A: a book that you think has a gorgeous cover
	E: read a graphic novel/comic/ manga
	O: Spongify (softening charm) – read a paperback book
Defense Against the Dark Arts	A: a book that is black under the dust jacket
	E: read the first book you remember from your TBR
	O: Cornish pixie! Swat it away with a book written by an English author or a book set in England
Divination	A: a book with a mostly white cover
	E: Read a short story or poem
	O: Read the last book you bought
Herbology	A: Mandrake! Put on your headphones and listen to an audiobook
	E: Read a book between 350-390 pages
	O: a book with a flower on the cover
History of Magic	A: Read a fantasy book
	E: Read a book that includes a map
	O: Reread a favorite or read a classic
Muggles Studies	A: Cover that includes an actual photo element (person, place, etc)
	E: a book set in the real world
	O: a book written by a person of color
Potions	A: Pollyjuice potion: read your friend's favorite book
	E: a book with a cover in your Hogwarts house color
	O: a book that starts with a prologue
Transfiguration	A: Read a mystery
	E: Read a book that's not a first in the series
	O: McGonagall does not mess around! Read a book over 500 pages
